06 Praise God for giving us salvation through the gospel, and making us His ambassadors to share this great news!	07 Pray that God would be first place in each of our lives, and that we seek first his kingdom and righteousness.	08 Ask God to give our Elders his insight and heart for NAC as they shepherd and oversee our church.	09 Pray we each recognize and overcome family sin patterns that too often seem "normal" to us.	10 Ask God to raise up the people He wants to serve as Elders, Gov. Board, Benevolent Committee and more.	11 Pray for God to lead our Nominating Committee to those He wants to serve in various areas of our church.	12 Ask God to put his anointing on our pastor and leaders, preparing all of us for a joyful time together tomorrow.
13 Praise God! He is good. We can trust him, even when we don't fully understand the adversity we face.	14 Ask God to develop the fruit of the Spirit of love in each of us individually and for it to mark our church as a whole.	15 Pray God's blessing and wisdom for our Governing Board and for preparing our budget for 2025.	16 Ask God to deepen our desire to meet with him daily, overflowing in sharing him often with others.	17 Ask God to supply all our financial needs and fulfill his purposes for NAC, using us for His glory.	18 Pray we are "kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you." (Eph.	19 Pray for God to move mightily in Guinea, West Africa and to bless the Solvigs as they share from their ministry.
20 Thank God that the gospel is having effect around the world, and we are part of it!	21 Ask God to help us trust him more, and through trust, to be more free to rest in practical ways.	22 Pray we identify and release our soul wounds to God, and that He heal and release us from their ongoing influence.	23 Pray we communicate truth graciously in our culture, sharing the reason for our hope with gentleness and respect.	24 Ask God to help us live in community with others and mutually encourage growing faith and friendship.	25 Pray that when we are tempted to operate in fear, we will instead stand in faith and live in God's freedom.	26 Ask God to speak to us deeply through his Word in our personal reading and as we come together as a church.
