Father!"	05 Pray we live our identity as His people known by His name, secure in His love and reflecting His holiness.	06 Pray for parents to be growing in Jesus, and encouraged to train their children to grow in faith as well.	07 Pray for God's blessing of revival and unity among all His followers in various churches in the Norwalk area.	08 Pray that the certainty of Christ's return gives us sure hope, clear focus, and renewed zeal.	09 Ask God to grip us with his kingdom values and priorities, such that it practically changes how we live and "do church."	10 Ask God to bless Love Norwalk today, with good weather, unified service, and effective witness.
11 Thank God that He invites us to freedom in his family, not just playing a religious game.	12 Ask God to give our Elders his insight and heart for NAC as they shepherd and oversee our church.	13 Pray for strength and joy as we serve at the Huron County Fair today, that we reflect Jesus well to all.	14 Ask God to help us all live fully for Jesus, boldly showing the gospel through our lives and words.	15 Pray we are transformed by God's Word and Spirit, and not squeezed into the mould of the world's values.	16 Pray that we will know and obey the Scriptures, and be sensitive to and follow the leading of the Holy Spirit.	17 Ask God to put his anointing on our leaders and pastor, preparing all of us for a joyful time together tomorrow.

25 Thank God for the fruit of the Spirit in us and helping us resist the pull of sin as we stay in step with Him.	26 Pray that God works each aspect of the fruit of the Spirit into our lives: love, joy, peace, patience...	27 ...kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. (Gal. 5:22-23)	28 Ask God to cultivate in us a hunger and thirst for righteousness, desiring to know and apply the Scriptures.	29 Ask God to grow in our church a family bond of love between believers, like how God loves us.	30 Pray for our young people to be grounded in faith and joyfully connected to the family of God.	31 Pray that God be first place in each of our lives, and that we have fresh appreciation of Jesus' sacrifice for us.
